

## DISPLAY RAIL OPERATION & INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

### DOOR FRAME MOUNTING

Display rails should be installed above door handles (door swings away from Patient Guard® Inserts)

1. Clean all door frames before mounting rails
2. Adhere three 3-inch tape strips to each rail
3. Align rail to door frame and press firmly (see illustration at right)

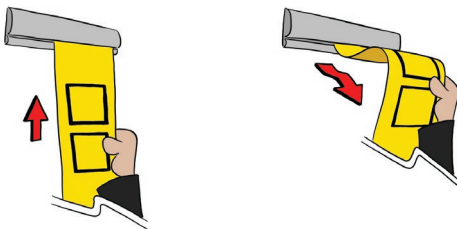
### WALL MOUNTING

Display rails should be installed at the same height as they appear on door frame to allow Patient Guard® Inserts to be read clearly (plus it looks cleaner that way).

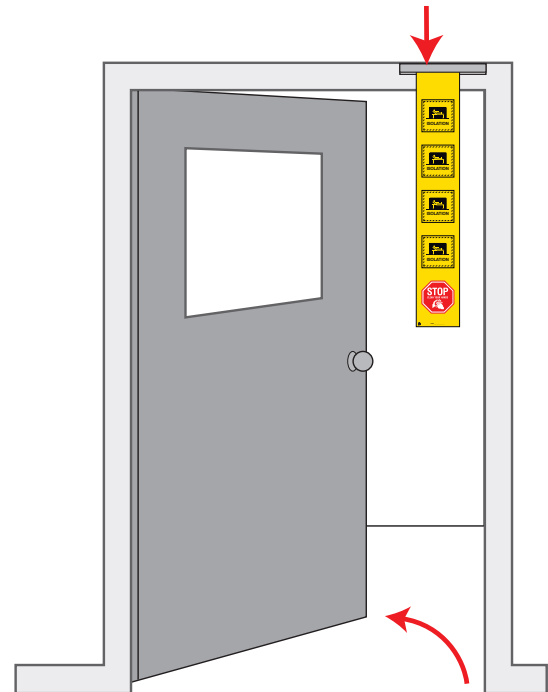
1. Clean wall area to accept rails and mark a level line
2. Adhere three 3-inch tape strips to each rail (or use mounting brackets)
3. Align rail to level line and press firmly

### RAIL OPERATION

Slip paper inserts evenly up into the display rail. To remove, lift free end while pulling away from rail.

### More usage ideas

- Mount on glass entranceways for two-sided outbreak messaging.
- Mount on a wall in waiting area or cafeteria to promote hand hygiene.
- Mount above hallway divider doors to isolate entire wards.
- Protect Emergency Department exam rooms.
- Secure every entrance to your facility during an outbreak.
